## Overview

The Kualu Rice Collaboration group is open to implementers, contributors, and anyone who is interested in implementing Kualu Rice in support of implementations of Kualu applications (KFS, KC, KS, etc) and for developing custom applications that leverage Kualu Rice.

This group meets regularly by teleconference as a venue for community engagement related to Kualu Rice efforts.

## Getting Involved

You will need to create a KIS account before you can join the mailing list, so that you can receive collaboration group emails, post comments, and add attachments.

- Instructions for how to get a KIS account:
  - Go to [kuali.org/kis](http://kuali.org/kis) and click on the "create account" link at the top of the page.
  - Fill out the requested information and then click submit.
  - After filling in all of the pages of information, you will be asked to check the email inbox for the account used to create your KIS account. In this email will be a link to create your password for Kuali. This password will work for all systems in Kuali, so make it one you will remember.
  - Follow the directions for creating your Kuali password.
  - At this point, it will ask you to log out.
- Instructions for adding yourself to the Rice collaboration emailing list:
  - Log into [KIS](#) (see the login at the top)
  - Click the "Collab Support" link on the left
  - Click the "Kuali Rice - Technical Collaboration" link
  - Click the green "Add self to group" button
- For those new to Kuali Rice, you can "[Test Drive](#)" the Kuali Rice sample applications and see what Rice can do for you!

If you also want to be able to log bugs against Kuali project code, you will also need to get a Jira and Confluence account (this can be done at any time later). See instructions at [Getting Started with Kuali](#).

## Investigating



You should always specify the version of Rice you are using, and any related information about your environment and customizations. You should always take the following steps

before sending a support request, and include any pertinent information about your results in your request...

- Verify that the issue exists, i.e. it is not the result of a misconfiguration on the part of the institution
- Verify that the issue exists in the test environment, i.e. it still needs to be worked on

1. Send an email to the [collaboration](#) group, asking for input. Provide a reasonable deadline, e.g. "please get back to me by Friday at 2 if you have any insight on this issue". (\* See note below if you are beta testing the 2.0 version of Rice!)
2. If you receive a response that helps to answer your question or resolve the issue and it is something that should be updated in the documentation, or if you do not obtain resolution to your issue via the collaboration list, enter a <https://test.kuali.org/jira/browse/KULRICE> and reply to your collaboration list inquiry with a link to the issue.
3. The Rice Team will...
  - Create an issue in the appropriate internal queue, so that the team can evaluate and schedule the work
  - Set the fix version appropriately on Jira issue, once the work has been scheduled for a release
  - Resolve the Jira issue when the fix is completed, and close it when the version is released
